## Program Structure

Queen's Graduate Diploma in Accounting program requires students to complete four courses for credit at the graduate level over a 12-week period from early-May until late-July. Each course is completed in a 3-week period. There are 12 hours of class time per week supplemented by individual study and course preparation. A detailed schedule is available on our website.

Students have the option of taking any or all of the four courses, however, only those students who successfully complete all four courses will be granted the Queen's Graduate Diploma in Accounting.

## Admission Requirements

- An undergraduate degree with an emphasis in accounting
- Successful completion of one university-level course in each of Introductory Taxation and Introductory Auditing, and a minimum of two university-level courses in Financial Accounting. (These prerequisites must be documented in official transcripts from the post-secondary institution(s) attended.)
- Completion of an Application Form (available on-line at [www.qsb.ca/gda](http://www.qsb.ca/gda)) by February 3, 2012.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$150 per course or \$500 for the full program is due upon acceptance into the program.
